JOHN Philip Foley is the founder and principal attorney at **Foley Law Offices**, an immigration law firm located in Faneuil Hall Marketplace in Boston.

Foley worked with the late Lurgan solicitor Rosemary Nelson to expose and reverse miscarriages of justice in Northern Ireland. He has provided legal advice to a number of Irish American organizations, and with the team at Foley Law Offices he has helped over 1,000 individuals (many of them from Ireland) become legal residents and then U.S. citizens.

Foley is second generation Irish American and he is an Irish citizen. All four of his grandparents are from Co. Galway, and he visits family in the Spiddal and Inverin section of Galway at least once a year.

Foley grew up in a strong Irish-American community in Portland, Maine where he says "everything, the music on the record player, the newspapers, the bread on the table was Irish."

Foley, a graduate of New England School of Law, has been a strong advocate for E-3 employment visas for the Irish and plans to open a branch of Foley Law Offices in Galway City in 2014.
